

# THE BIBLE STUDY PROGRAM

## WEEK 32 – Deuteronomy 34 – Joshua 5 & Luke 19 – 20

**Overview** – This study is a 6 day program covering both the Old Testament (OT) and the New Testament (NT). This study program is to take place on a daily basis (Monday through Saturday). The study will involve reading/studying 6 OT chapters and 2 NT chapters per week. The OT chapters will only be covered 1 time with the NT chapters being covered 3 times. Depending on reading speed, chapter length, etc., total study time should take approximately 15 to 30 minutes a day. In other words, by simply dedicating **only** about 15 to 30 minutes a day (6 days a week) to Bible study, **in roughly 2 ½ to 3 years, you will have read and studied the entire Bible.** If followed, you will have read the OT once and the NT three times, while studying through the entire Bible. The KJV (King James Version) is used to prepare the questions.

**How it works** – Read, study, and/or answer questions as outlined below. Place an “x” in the blank after you have completed each day’s study. If you are unable to do the study on the set day, either try to “double up” and get back on schedule or if you get several days behind, simply skip to the current day’s schedule. If necessary you can always come back weeks or months later and study the chapters you missed. You will be able to identify any missed chapters easily if you consistently mark your studied chapters with an “x.” Practically speaking, however, this is not advisable and the student is encouraged to “stay on the daily schedule.” In short, this program will not work, if you do not commit yourself to a daily study habit. We also suggest that the student keeps the weekly study program sheets in a 3 ring binder for easy reference. It is likewise necessary that everyone in the local congregation who is involved in this study program get together weekly or at least biweekly to review the questions and answers.

2. **Monday** –

1) Deuteronomy 34 – Read & Answer Below

- a) In what mountain did Moses go, to see the Promised Land? What was the specific hill/place, within the mountain?
- b) In what verse does God remind Moses about the land promise to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob?
- c) In Deuteronomy 34:5, Moses is referred to as “the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Lord.”
- d) How old was Moses when he died?
- e) Did Moses look old and worn-out at the time of his death?
- f) How many days did the children of Israel weep/mourn for Moses when he died?
- g) What great leader was chosen by God as the successor of Moses?
- h) Was Moses considered a very unique/special prophet?

2) Luke 19 – Read Only

3. **Tuesday** –

1) Joshua 1 – Read & Answer Below

- a) Moses is referenced as being God’s \_\_\_\_\_ “two times” within the first two verses of this chapter.
- b) What was the name of Joshua’s father?
- c) Before the death of Moses, in what capacity did Joshua work with/under Moses?
- d) In what verse does God tell Joshua, “as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee?”
- e) Joshua 1:8 says, “This \_\_\_\_\_ of the law shall \_\_\_\_\_ depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt \_\_\_\_\_ therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to \_\_\_\_\_ according to \_\_\_\_\_ that is \_\_\_\_\_ therein: for \_\_\_\_\_ thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have \_\_\_\_\_ success.”
- f) What specific tribes did Joshua remind about their promise to help their brethren in the conquest of Canaan?
- g) Did these tribes agree to help as they had formerly promised?

2) Luke 19 – Read & Answer Below

- a) What was the name of the man who “was the chief among the publicans, and he was rich?”
- b) Was this man tall or short?
- c) What type of tree did he climb up into in order to better see Jesus?
- d) Who went to this man’s house?
- e) Which verse records Jesus as saying, “For the Son of man is come to seek and save that which was lost?”
- f) In what verse does Jesus say, “...Out of thine own mouth will I judge thee, thou wicked servant...?”

- g) In what verse does Jesus say, “For I say unto you, That unto every one which hath shall be given; and from him that hath not, even that he hath shall be taken away from him?”
- h) What mountain is referenced as being at/near “Bethphage and Bethany?”
- i) In what verse does Jesus say, “...I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out?”
- j) What verse references the fact, regarding Jesus, as pertaining to the common people, that “all the people were very attentive to hear him?”

1) Joshua 2 – Read & Answer Below

- a) How many spies did Joshua send out to “spy secretly...the land, even Jericho?”
- b) Whose house did the two men find lodging/refuge in?
- c) In what specific location, in relation to the house, did Rahab hide the spies?
- d) In Joshua 2:9-10, Rahab says, “...I \_\_\_\_\_ that the Lord hath given you the land...For we have \_\_\_\_\_ how the Lord dried up the water of the Red Sea....”
- e) Was the credible testimony that Rahab heard able to produce faith within her regarding the validity of God?
- f) Where was Rahab’s house located within the city?
- g) What did Rahab bind in the window as a means of identification for her house during the upcoming invasion?
- h) When the two spies reported back to Joshua, did they give a report indicating that the Israelites would be able to take the land or was their report fully of worry and dread?

2) Luke 19 – Read & Word Study/Research

- a) What city was Jesus in, when he encountered Zacchaeus?
- b) Did Zacchaeus receive Jesus with fear, grief, anger or joy?
- c) Before Jesus gave the parable about “A certain nobleman [who] went into a far country,” Luke 19:11 says that Jesus “...spake a parable, because He was nigh to \_\_\_\_\_, and because they thought that the \_\_\_\_\_ of God should \_\_\_\_\_ appear.”
- d) Was the servant who “gained ten pounds” the only one who was blessed?
- e) Jesus says in Luke 19:27, “But those mine \_\_\_\_\_, which would not that I should \_\_\_\_\_ over them, bring hither, and \_\_\_\_\_ them before Me.”
- f) What verse says, “...Blessed be the King that cometh in the name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest?”

5. **Thursday** –

1) Joshua 3 – Read & Answer Below

- a) In reference to the Ark of the Covenant, the Israelites are told to follow it as it would lead them into Canaan, but are also reminded, “...come not near unto it, that ye may know the way by which ye must go: for ye have not passed this way heretofore.” In what verse is this quote found?
- b) What did Joshua tell the people to do to themselves in Joshua 3:5?

- c) In what verse does God say to Joshua, "...This day will I begin to magnify thee in the sight of all Israel, that they may know that, as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee?"
- d) Joshua 3:10 reads, "And \_\_\_\_\_ said, Hereby ye shall \_\_\_\_\_ that the \_\_\_\_\_ God is among you, and that He will without fail drive out from before you the \_\_\_\_\_ and the...."
- e) How did the Israelites (i.e., hundreds and hundreds of thousands) cross the Jordan River (which had flooded its banks at this time, vs. 15)?
- f) Did the Jordan River part "before" or "after" they did what God said (i.e., before or after the priest's feet dipped in the water)? In other words, did the waters miraculously separate "the moment they believed" or "when their faith/belief was coupled with their obedience?"
- g) What verse in this chapter specifically states that they crossed on "dry ground?"

6. **Friday** –

1) Joshua 4 – Read & Answer Below

- a) How many men were specially picked to retrieve stones?
- b) What tribes were these men to be from?
- c) Was there a specific location from which they were to gather the stones?
- d) These stones were to be used to build "a \_\_\_\_\_ unto the children of Israel forever."
- e) What was the name of the place (i.e., it is the same as the lodging place they encamped in the first time after crossing Jordan) that this memorial was to be built in?
- f) How many from "the children of Reuben...Gad, and half the tribe of Manasseh, passed over armed before the children of Israel...prepared for war?"
- g) Was Joshua a well-respected leader among the Israelites?
- h) What verse specifically states that the Israelites crossed Jordan on "dry land?"
- i) Referencing the miraculous parting of the Red Sea and the Jordan River, what verse says that this was done "that all the people of the earth might know the hand of the Lord, that it is mighty...?"

2) Luke 20 – Read & Answer Below

- a) What was Jesus doing in the Temple as recorded in Luke 20:1?
- b) What were the two questions that they asked Jesus that provoked Jesus to ask them about the baptism of John?
- c) Did Jesus do what He did by (or according to) authority?
- d) In the parable of the man who planted a vineyard and lent it out to husbandmen (or farmers), what did they do to the son?
- e) What verse says, regarding the chief priest and scribes, that they "sought to lay hands on Him [i.e., Jesus – JBR]; and they feared the people: for they perceived that He had spoken this parable against them?"
- f) What verse specifically states that there will NOT be marriage or giving of marriage in "that world" (i.e., eternity)?

- g) Referring to those “accounted worthy to obtain that world, and the resurrection from the dead,” Luke 20:36 reads, “Neither can they \_\_\_\_\_ anymore: for they are equal unto the \_\_\_\_\_.”
- h) In what verse does Jesus refer to the concept of some who “shall receive greater damnation?”

7. **Saturday** –

1) Joshua 5 – Read & Answer Below

- a) When the Amorites and Canaanites heard about the Israelites crossing Jordan in miraculous fashion, the text says “their \_\_\_\_\_ melted, neither was there \_\_\_\_\_ in them anymore, because of the children of Israel.”
- b) Per Joshua 5:2, what was Joshua commanded to do with Israel’s males? Did Joshua carry out this commandment?
- c) Why did this commandment need to be carried out “again” or “the second time” as noted in Joshua 5:2?
- d) In what verse does Scripture say specifically that the reason that the former generation was not allowed to enter the land of promise was “because they obeyed not...?”
- e) What verse references the cessation of the miraculous giving of Manna that they Israelites had been blessed with for many years?
- f) When Joshua came face to face with “the captain of the host of the Lord,” what was this heavenly one holding in his hand?
- g) What did Joshua do when he encountered this person?
- h) What was Joshua told to take off?

2) Luke 20 – Read & Word Study/Research

- a) In Luke 20:1-8, what form of teaching did Jesus use to silence the chief priests, scribes and elders?
- b) What Old Testament Scripture is alluded to in Luke 20:17-18?
- c) Luke 20:20 declares, “And they \_\_\_\_\_ Him, and sent forth \_\_\_\_\_, which should \_\_\_\_\_ themselves just men, that they might take hold of His \_\_\_\_\_, that so they might \_\_\_\_\_ Him unto the power and authority of the governor.”
- d) In what verse does Jesus give the famous statement, “...Render therefore unto Caesar the things which be Caesar’s, and unto God the things which be God’s?”
- e) Read Luke 20:37-38. How do these verses show that there is life after death?
- f) What powerful teaching technique does Jesus use as referenced in Luke 20:41 and 44?
- g) What Old Testament Scripture is referenced in Luke 20:42-43?
