

# THE BIBLE STUDY PROGRAM

## WEEK 79 – Job 33 – 38 & 2 Corinthians 8 – 9

**Overview** – This study is a 6 day program covering both the Old Testament (OT) and the New Testament (NT). This study program is to take place on a daily basis (Monday through Saturday). The study will involve reading/studying 6 OT chapters and 2 NT chapters per week. The OT chapters will only be covered 1 time with the NT chapters being covered 3 times. Depending on reading speed, chapter length, etc., total study time should take approximately 15 to 30 minutes a day. In other words, by simply dedicating **only** about 15 to 30 minutes a day (6 days a week) to Bible study, **in roughly 2 ½ to 3 years, you will have read and studied the entire Bible.** If followed, you will have read the OT once and the NT three times, while studying through the entire Bible. The KJV (King James Version) is used to prepare the questions.

**How it works** – Read, study, and/or answer questions as outlined below. Place an “x” in the blank after you have completed each day’s study. If you are unable to do the study on the set day, either try to “double up” and get back on schedule or if you get several days behind, simply skip to the current day’s schedule. If necessary you can always come back weeks or months later and study the chapters you missed. You will be able to identify any missed chapters easily if you consistently mark your studied chapters with an “x.” Practically speaking, however, this is not advisable and the student is encouraged to “stay on the daily schedule.” In short, this program will not work, if you do not commit yourself to a daily study habit. We also suggest that the student keeps the weekly study program sheets in a 3 ring binder for easy reference. It is likewise necessary that everyone in the local congregation who is involved in this study program get together weekly or at least biweekly to review the questions and answers.

2. **Monday** –

1) Job 33 – Read & Answer Below

- a) As this chapter opens, what person is speaking?
- b) Job 33:1 reads, “Wherefore, \_\_\_\_\_, I pray thee hear my \_\_\_\_\_, and hearken to all my words.”
- c) In what verse does Elihu declare to Job, “Behold, I am according to thy wish in God’s stead: I also am formed out of the clay?”
- d) What verse reads, “Behold, in this thou art not just: I will answer thee, that God is greater than man?”
- e) In Job 33:13 Elihu asks, “Why dost thou \_\_\_\_\_ against Him? For he giveth \_\_\_\_\_ account of any of His matters.”
- f) In what verse does Elihu say, “Mark well, O Job, hearken unto me: hold thy peace, and I will speak?”
- g) Job 33:33 states, “If not, hearken unto me: \_\_\_\_\_ thy peace, and I shall \_\_\_\_\_ thee \_\_\_\_\_.”

1) Job 34 – Read & Answer Below

- a) Job 34:1 continues, “Furthermore \_\_\_\_\_ answered and said.”
- b) What are the first four words of Job 34:5?
- c) Referring again to what “Job hath said,” Job 34:9 reads, “For he hath said, It profiteth a man \_\_\_\_\_ that he should delight himself with \_\_\_\_\_.”
- d) Read Job 34:17-20. Based on this text, is God a respecter of persons?
- e) Speaking of God, what verse declares, “For His eyes are upon the ways of man, and He seeth all His goings?”
- f) What verse contains the phrase, “...whether it be done against a nation, or against a man only?”
- g) Referencing some of the misguided statements of the faithful (but depressed) Job, Job 34:35 declares, “\_\_\_\_\_ hath spoken without \_\_\_\_\_, and his words were without \_\_\_\_\_.”
- h) The last statement of the last verse in this chapter tells us that Job “...multiplieth his \_\_\_\_\_ against \_\_\_\_\_.”

2) 2 Corinthians 8 – Read & Answer Below

- a) The first verse of this chapter speaks of “the grace of God bestowed on the churches of \_\_\_\_\_.”
- b) Were these “churches of Macedonia” wealthy?
- c) What early verse in this chapter discusses “the fellowship of the ministering to the saints?”
- d) 2 Corinthians 8:5 tells us that these faithful Saints, “first gave their own \_\_\_\_\_ to the \_\_\_\_\_, and unto us by the will of God.”

- e) According to the end of 2 Corinthians 8:8, would the Corinthians contribution “prove the sincerity of [their] love?”
- f) What ultimate example of giving did Paul use in showing the true nature of giving?
- g) In reference to the giving/collection, in what verse did Paul plainly tell the Corinthian brethren, “Now therefore perform the doing of it?”
- h) 2 Corinthians 8:12 declares, “For if there be first a \_\_\_\_\_ mind, it is accepted according to that a man \_\_\_\_\_, and not according to that he hath not.”
- i) What Old Testament Scripture is referenced in 2 Corinthians 8:15?
- j) What verse reads, “Providing for honest things, not only in the sight of the Lord, but also in the sight of men?”

5. **Thursday** –

1) Job 36 – Read & Answer Below

- a) As this chapter opens, what person is still speaking?
- b) Job 36:1 reads, “\_\_\_\_\_ also proceeded, and said.”
- c) According to Job 36:2, does Elihu claim to be speaking on God’s behalf?

- d) Another verse which seems to be setting forth the fact that Elihu was a prophet from God is Job 36:4. It says, “For truly my \_\_\_\_\_ shall not be false: he that is perfect in \_\_\_\_\_ is with thee.”
- e) In what verse in this chapter does Elihu say that God in His providential workings establishes kings on their thrones, and exalts them?
- f) What verse declares, “But the hypocrites in heart heap up wrath...?”
- g) What verse states, “Behold, God exalteth by His power: who teacheth like Him?”
- h) A key verse is Job 36:26. This verse refers to the fact that God’s providential ways are beyond our understanding. It reads, “Behold, \_\_\_\_\_ is great, and we know Him \_\_\_\_\_, neither can the number of His years be \_\_\_\_\_ out.”

6. **Friday** –

1) Job 37 – Read & Answer Below

- a) As this chapter opens, what person is still speaking?
- b) Job 37:5 is another key verse. It reads, “\_\_\_\_\_ thundereth marvellously with His voice; great things doeth He, which we \_\_\_\_\_ comprehend.”
- c) Discussing God’s great power and control in nature, Job 37:12 tells us, “And it is turned round about by His \_\_\_\_\_: that they may do whatsoever He \_\_\_\_\_ them upon the face of the \_\_\_\_\_ in the earth.”
- d) What verse reads, “Hearken unto this, O Job: stand still, and consider the wondrous works of God?”
- e) In Job 37:16, Elihu asks, “Dost thou know the balancings of the clouds, the wondrous works of Him which is perfect in knowledge?” The entity who is “perfect in knowledge” of which Elihu speaks is \_\_\_\_\_.
- f) Job 37:22 plainly says, “...with \_\_\_\_\_ is terrible majesty.”
- g) Again speaking of God’s great majesty power and providence, Job 37:23 begins, “Touching the \_\_\_\_\_, we \_\_\_\_\_ find Him out: He is excellent in power, and in judgment, and in plenty of justice....”
- h) What verse begins, “Men do therefore fear Him...?”

- a) Speaking to the Corinthians, in what verse does Paul say, “Achaia was ready a year ago; and your zeal hath provoked very many?”
- b) In what verse does Paul speak of sending “the brethren, lest our boasting of you should be in vain in this behalf...?”
- c) 2 Corinthians 9:6 reads, “But this I say, He which \_\_\_\_\_ sparingly shall \_\_\_\_\_ also sparingly; and he which soweth \_\_\_\_\_ shall reap also \_\_\_\_\_.”
- d) What type of “giver” does God love?
- e) The last part of what verse reads, “...may abound to every good work?”
- f) The last part of what two verses discuss the concept of “thanksgivings unto God?”
- g) What verse reads, “Thanks be unto God for His unspeakable gift?”

7. **Saturday** –

1) Job 38 – Read & Answer Below

- a) As this chapter opens, \_\_\_\_\_ begins speaking.
- b) Job 38:1 reads, “Then the \_\_\_\_\_ answered \_\_\_\_\_ out of the whirlwind, and said.”
- c) In Job 38:2, God asks, “Who is this that darkeneth \_\_\_\_\_ by words without \_\_\_\_\_?”
- d) In Job 38:3, God challenges the inquisitive Job thusly, “Gird up now thy loins like a \_\_\_\_\_; for I will \_\_\_\_\_ of thee, and answer thou Me.”
- e) In what verse does God ask Job, “Where was thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? Declare, if thou hast understanding.”
- f) Does Job 38:16 reference “the springs of the sea?”
- g) Job 38:18 declares, “Hast thou perceived the breadth of the \_\_\_\_\_? Declare \_\_\_\_\_ thou knowest it all.”
- h) What verse finds God asking, “Hath the rain a father? Or who hath begotten the drops of dew?”
- i) In what verse does God say, “Canst thou send lightnings, that they may go, and say unto thee, Here we are?”

- d) 2 Corinthians 9:7 reads, “Every man according as he \_\_\_\_\_ in his heart, so let him \_\_\_\_\_; not \_\_\_\_\_, or of \_\_\_\_\_: for God loveth a \_\_\_\_\_ giver.”
- e) Does 2 Corinthians 9:7 discuss/command “tithing” or does it discuss/command giving based on prosperity and as one “purposeth in his heart?”
