

# THE BIBLE STUDY PROGRAM

## WEEK 86 – Psalm 33 – 38 & Ephesians 3 – 4

**Overview** – This study is a 6 day program covering both the Old Testament (OT) and the New Testament (NT). This study program is to take place on a daily basis (Monday through Saturday). The study will involve reading/studying 6 OT chapters and 2 NT chapters per week. The OT chapters will only be covered 1 time with the NT chapters being covered 3 times. Depending on reading speed, chapter length, etc., total study time should take approximately 15 to 30 minutes a day. In other words, by simply dedicating **only** about 15 to 30 minutes a day (6 days a week) to Bible study, **in roughly 2 ½ to 3 years, you will have read and studied the entire Bible.** If followed, you will have read the OT once and the NT three times, while studying through the entire Bible. The KJV (King James Version) is used to prepare the questions.

**How it works** – Read, study, and/or answer questions as outlined below. Place an “x” in the blank after you have completed each day’s study. If you are unable to do the study on the set day, either try to “double up” and get back on schedule or if you get several days behind, simply skip to the current day’s schedule. If necessary you can always come back weeks or months later and study the chapters you missed. You will be able to identify any missed chapters easily if you consistently mark your studied chapters with an “x.” Practically speaking, however, this is not advisable and the student is encouraged to “stay on the daily schedule.” In short, this program will not work, if you do not commit yourself to a daily study habit. We also suggest that the student keeps the weekly study program sheets in a 3 ring binder for easy reference. It is likewise necessary that everyone in the local congregation who is involved in this study program get together weekly or at least biweekly to review the questions and answers.

2. **Monday** –

1) Psalm 33 – Read & Answer Below

- a) This psalm begins, “\_\_\_\_\_ in the Lord, O ye \_\_\_\_\_.”
- b) What verse declares, “For the word of the Lord is right...?”
- c) What verse reminds us, “...the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord?”
- d) Psalm 33:6 reads, “By the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Lord were the \_\_\_\_\_ made; and all the host of them by the \_\_\_\_\_ of His \_\_\_\_\_.”
- e) Psalm 33:8 states, “Let all the \_\_\_\_\_ fear the Lord: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in \_\_\_\_\_ of Him.”
- f) Psalm 33:12 famously reads, “Blessed is the \_\_\_\_\_ whose God is the Lord...”
- g) What three verse section in this chapter speaks of God looking from heaven and beholding the sons of men and considering all their works?
- h) What verse declares, “Behold, the eye of the Lord is upon them that fear Him, upon them that hope in His mercy?”
- i) In Psalm 33:20 the psalmist says, “Our soul waiteth for the Lord.” He goes on to say that the Lord is “...our \_\_\_\_\_ and our \_\_\_\_\_.”

2) Ephesians 3 – Read Only

3. **Tuesday** –

1) Psalm 34 – Read & Answer Below

- a) In Psalm 34:4, David pens, “I sought the \_\_\_\_\_, and He heard Me, and \_\_\_\_\_ me from all my fears.”
- b) In what verse does the text read, “This poor man cried, and the Lord heard him, and saved him out of all his troubles?”
- c) Is there a verse in this chapter that speaks of “the angel of the Lord” delivering a certain group?
- d) What verse beautifully begins, “O taste and see that the Lord is good...?”
- e) What does the second-half of Psalm 34:8 declare?
- f) What verse reads, “...but they that seek the Lord shall not want any good thing?”
- g) What verse in this chapter declares, “\_\_\_\_\_ from evil, and do \_\_\_\_\_; seek \_\_\_\_\_, and pursue it.”
- h) Does this chapter clearly state that God hears the prayers of the righteous/godly, but equally as clear in the fact that God does NOT hear the prayers of the evil?
- i) The statement, “He keepeth all His bones: not one of them is broken,” is found in what verse?

2) Ephesians 3 – Read & Answer Below

- a) Who was the human penman of this God-inspired epistle?
- b) Speaking of Paul’s inspired message, Ephesians 3:3-4 declares, “How that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery; (as I \_\_\_\_\_ afore in few

\_\_\_\_\_, Whereby, when ye \_\_\_\_\_, ye may \_\_\_\_\_ my knowledge in the mystery of Christ).”

- c) The end of Ephesians 3:5 makes it clear that “the mystery” (which was written down for man’s reading and understanding) was “revealed” unto God’s “holy apostles and prophets” by the \_\_\_\_\_.
- d) Referring to “Paul” what verse reads, “that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ?”
- e) Was the plan of God (i.e., the scheme of redemption, the church, etc.) in the purpose of God before the world ever began?

##### 1) Psalm 35 – Read & Answer Below

- a) The first verse of this chapter sets the overall theme of the chapter. Psalm 35:1 reads, “Plead my cause, O \_\_\_\_\_, with them that strive with me: \_\_\_\_\_ against \_\_\_\_\_ that \_\_\_\_\_ against \_\_\_\_\_.”
- b) Figuratively speaking, as this chapter opens, what specific weapons of warfare did David ask God to “take hold of” and “draw out?”
- c) In what verse does David say (i.e., regarding his enemies), “Let them be as chaff before the wind: and let the angel of the Lord chase them?”
- d) What are the first five words of Psalm 35:7?
- e) In what verse does David state, “False witnesses did rise up...?”
- f) In Psalm 35:13 the inspired penman wrote, “...I humbled my soul with \_\_\_\_\_.”
- g) In what verse does David speak of “hypocritical mockers in feasts...?”
- h) In what verse does the writer inquire, “Lord, how long wilt Thou look on?”
- i) Psalm 35:19 states, “Let not them that are mine \_\_\_\_\_ wrongfully rejoice over me: neither let them \_\_\_\_\_ with the eye that \_\_\_\_\_ me \_\_\_\_\_ a cause.”
- j) In Psalm 35:23, David begs of God, “Stir up Thyself, and \_\_\_\_\_ to my \_\_\_\_\_.”

##### 2) Ephesians 3 – Read & Word Study/Research

- a) According to Ephesians 3:3-4 are men able to know/understand God’s scheme of redemption/plan of salvation?
- b) According to Ephesians 3:5 was God’s revealed “mystery” invented by mankind?
- c) In what verse does the humble Paul refer to himself as “less than the least of all saints?”
- d) Before the church age and the revelation of the scheme of redemption—through the apostles to us—did mankind understand “how” God would save lost humanity?
- e) In what verse does Paul tell the Ephesians brethren, “Wherefore I desire that ye faint not at my tribulations...?”

- f) What verse in this chapter makes references to mankind's immortal soul with the words, "the inner man?"
- g) According to Ephesians 3:17, Christ dwells in the Christian's heart "by \_\_\_\_\_."
- h) Ephesians 3:19 states, "And to \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God."

- b) Still describing the wicked, Psalm 36:2 begins, "For he \_\_\_\_\_ himself in his \_\_\_\_\_ eyes...."
- c) The last phrase of Psalm 36:4 describes the wicked thusly, "...he abhorreth \_\_\_\_\_ evil."
- d) The psalmist describes God's "righteousness" as being like the great mountains, the great ocean or a strong horse?
- e) Psalm 36:7 says, "How excellent is Thy \_\_\_\_\_, O God!"
- f) Speaking of the righteous who put their trust in God, Psalm 36:8 declares, "...Thou shalt make them drink of the \_\_\_\_\_ of Thy \_\_\_\_\_."
- g) In what verse is the phrase, "in Thy light shall we see light" found?

2) Ephesians 4 – Read Only

6. **Friday** –

1) Psalm 37 – Read & Answer Below

- a) Psalm 37:1 is a great and powerful verse. It reads, "Fret \_\_\_\_\_ thyself because of \_\_\_\_\_, neither be thou \_\_\_\_\_ against workers of \_\_\_\_\_."
- b) Psalm 37:2 gives the reason why when it continues, "For they shall soon be \_\_\_\_\_ down like the \_\_\_\_\_, and wither as the green herb."
- c) Psalm 37:3 gives the answer. It states, "\_\_\_\_\_ in the Lord, and \_\_\_\_\_ good."
- d) What verse in this chapter begins, "Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for Him...?"
- e) What verse begins, "But the meek shall inherit the earth...?"
- f) Referencing the wicked, Psalm 37:13 declares, "The Lord shall \_\_\_\_\_ at him: for He seeth that his day is \_\_\_\_\_."
- g) Psalm 37:16 forever tells us, "A little that a \_\_\_\_\_ man hath is \_\_\_\_\_ than the \_\_\_\_\_ of many \_\_\_\_\_."
- h) What verse reads, "The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord...?"
- i) What verse contains the phrase, "For the Lord...forsaketh not His saints...?"
- j) Speaking of the righteous, Psalm 37:31 declares, "The \_\_\_\_\_ of his God is in his \_\_\_\_\_; none of his \_\_\_\_\_ shall slide."
- k) The last phrase of this chapter tells us "why" God will deliver/save the righteous. It says, "...because they \_\_\_\_\_ in Him."

2) Ephesians 4 – Read & Answer Below

- a) This chapter starts thusly, "I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye \_\_\_\_\_ worthy of the \_\_\_\_\_ wherewith ye are called."

- b) Ephesians 4:2 continues, “With all \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_, with \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ one another in love.”
- c) According to Ephesians 4:4, how many bodies (i.e., churches – cf., Ephesians 1:22-23, etc.) are there?
- d) According to Ephesians 4:5, just as there is but “One Lord,” so there is also but “\_\_\_\_\_ faith” and “\_\_\_\_\_ baptism.”
- e) Referencing Christ, what verse in this chapter contains the phrase, “He led captivity captive?”
- f) What verse talks about, “...speaking the truth in love...?”
- g) In Ephesians 4:17, Paul plainly states, “This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk \_\_\_\_\_ as other \_\_\_\_\_ walk, in the \_\_\_\_\_ of their \_\_\_\_\_.”
- h) In what verse does Paul speak of some “Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness?”

1) Psalm 38 – Read & Answer Below

- a) In the opening verses of this chapter, David says, “...neither is there any rest in my bones.” He says that such is, “because of my \_\_\_\_\_.”
- b) Continuing the discussion regarding the burden of sin, Psalm 38:4 says, “For mine \_\_\_\_\_ are gone over mine head: as an heavy \_\_\_\_\_ they are too \_\_\_\_\_ for me.”
- c) Talking to God, in what verse does the psalmist say, “...my groaning is not hid from Thee?”

- a) What verse in this chapter reads, “Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace?”
- b) List the “Seven Ones” of Ephesians 4:4-6.
- c) By the time Paul penned Ephesians chapter four, how many baptisms did he say should be taught?
- d) What Old Testament Scripture is quoted in Ephesians 4:8?
- e) What verse (referring to various offices that existed and/or that still exist within the church) makes mention of “apostles...prophets...evangelists, etc.?”
- f) What verse reads, “For the perfecting of the saints for the work of the ministry for the edifying of the body of Christ?”

- g) What is Paul talking about in Ephesians 4:13-14?
- h) Referring to non-Christians, what verse speaks of "...the blindness of their heart?"
- i) Putting Christians in opposition to non-Christians (i.e., those with "blindness of...heart" and those who are "past feeling"), what verse says (of the Christians), "But ye have not so learned Christ?"
- j) What verse says to Christians, "Be ye angry, and sin not...?"
- k) Ephesians 4:31 reads, "Let all \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_, and evil \_\_\_\_\_, be put away from you, with all \_\_\_\_\_."
