- 1) Numbers 34 Read & Answer Below
 - a) What was the name of the land that the Israelites were to obtain for their inheritance? (The land of Canaan, vs. 2)
 - b) What verse begins the discussion regarding "the western border" of the land? (Numbers 34:6)
 - c) How many tribes received their inheritance before Jordan? How many tribes received their inheritance in the land of Canaan? (2 ¹/₂ tribes Reuben, Gad and ¹/₂ the tribe of Manasseh received their inheritance before Jordan. The other 9 ¹/₂ tribes received their inheritance within the land of Canaan, vs. 13-15)
 - d) Numbers 34:18 says, "And ye shall take one ______ of _____ tribe, to divide the land by inheritance." (prince; every)
 - e) What was the name of the prince "of the tribe of Judah?" (Caleb, vs. 19)
 - f) What was the name of "the prince of the tribe of the children of Asher?" (Ahihud, vs. 27)

3. <u>Tuesday</u> –

- 1) <u>Numbers 35 Read & Answer Below</u>
 - a) Were the Levites to receive anything for their inheritance? Is so, what were they to receive? (Yes. God through Moses commanded saying, "...give unto the Levites of the inheritance of their possession cities...and...suburbs for the cities round about them," vs. 2)
 - b) According to Numbers 35:4, the suburbs of the cities of the Levites were to reach "from the wall of the city and outward a ______ cubits round about." (thousand)
 - c) How many cities of refuge were to be given to the Levites? (Six cities, vs. 6)
 - d) How many additional cities were to be given to the Levites? (Forty-two cities, vs. 6)

 - f) What was the purpose of the cities of refuge, per Numbers 35:11? (As it says, "...that the slayer may flee thither, which killeth any person at unawares" (i.e., accidentally))
 - g) Were the cities of refuge designed to protect the murderer? (No, vs. 16-21)
 - h) How long was the unintentional slayer to "abide" in the city of refuge? (Until the death of the high priest, vs. 25, 28)
 - i) What was the penalty for the actual murderer? (The death penalty, vs. 30-31)

- 2) <u>Luke 7 Read & Answer Below</u>
 - a) What was wrong with the centurion's servant? (He was sick and ready to die, vs. 2)
 - b) What had this "certain centurion" previously built for the Jews? (A synagogue, vs. 5)
 - c) Was this centurion a humble or arrogant person? (Humble. He sent servants to Jesus saying, "I am not worthy that thou shouldest enter under my roof: Wherefore neither thought I myself worthy to come unto Thee: but say in a word, and my servant shall be healed, vs. 6-7)
 - d) Regarding the dead man that Jesus raised up, how many sons did his mother have in addition to him? (None. The text says that he was "the only son of his mother, and she was a widow," vs. 12)
 - e) Beginning in Luke 7:24, what person does Jesus begin to speak highly of? (John the Baptizer)
 - f) What was the woman doing who stood at the feet of Jesus? (She was weeping and kissing His feet. Likewise, she washed his feet with her tears, drying them with the hair of her head. Also, she anointed his feet with the precious ointment, vs. 38. A key is found in vs. 37 when it says that she "was a sinner." This is grand description of remorse and repentance! Compare also, vs. 44-46.)
 - g) What verse shows Jesus forgiving her sins? (Luke 7:48)

 - b) What verse says, "So shall not the inheritance of the children of Israel remove from tribe to tribe...?" (Numbers 36:7)
 - c) Did the daughters of Zelophehad adhere to the commandments of Moses regarding the specifics of their marriages? (Yes, vs. 10)
 - d) List the names of the daughters of Zelophehad, as mentioned in this chapter? (Mahlah, Tirzah, Hoglah, Milcah and Noah, vs. 11)
 - e) Numbers 36:12 says, "And they were ______ into the families of the sons of ______ the son of Joseph, and their ______ remained in the tribe of the family of their father." (married; Manasseh; inheritance)
- 2) Luke 7 Read & Word Study/Research
 - a) In what verse did Jesus say, "...I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel?" (Luke 7:9)
 - b) What city was Jesus in when he raised the widow's son from the dead? (The city of Nain, vs. 11)
 - c) Luke 7:22 reads, "Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell ______ what things ye have seen and heard; how that the ______ see, the lame _____, the _____ are cleansed, the ______ hear, the _____ are raised, to the poor the ______ is preached." (John; blind; walk; lepers; deaf; dead; gospel)

- g) In what verse does Jesus say, "... Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace?" (Luke 7:50)

 - a) Obviously referring to the inspired spokesman of God, Deuteronomy 1:1 plainly says, "These be the words which spake...." (Moses)
 - b) What land was Moses in when he "began...to declare this law...?" (He was in the land of Moab, on this side Jordan, vs. 5. This is referring to Moses giving a re-statement of the law before his death and before they entered the land of Canaan. Remember, all of those over 20 (save Caleb and Joshua) had died in the wilderness.)
 - c) Deuteronomy 1:8 records, "Behold, I have set the land before you: go in and possess the _____ which the Lord sware unto your fathers, _____ Isaac, and _____, to give to them and their seed after them." (land; Abraham; Jacob)
 - d) What verse says, "Ye shall not respect persons in judgment; but ye shall hear the small as well as the great...." (Deuteronomy 1:17)
 - e) As Moses reminds them of their history, we are reminded that there were spies originally sent into the land of Canaan. (Twelve, vs. 23)
 - f) What verse says of Israel, "Yet in this thing ye did not believe the Lord your God...?" (Deuteronomy 1:32)
 - g) What two men were specifically mentioned as being able to enter the land of Canaan because of their faithfulness? (Caleb and Joshua, vs. 36, 38)

 - g) What was the name of the place where "Sihon came out against [Israel], he and all his people, to fight?" (Jahaz, vs. 32)

 - e) According to Luke 8:13, is it possible to "fall away?" (Yes. This is too obvious to miss. It says, "...which for a while believe, and in time of temptation FALL AWAY.")
 - f) Luke 8:17 says, "For ______ is secret, that shall not be made manifest; neither anything hid, that shall not be ______ and come abroad." (nothing; known)
 - g) Jesus said that His mother and brethren "are those which _____ the word of God, and ____ it." (hear; do, vs. 21)
 - h) Jesus raised the a ruler of the synagogue's daughter from the dead. What was his (i.e., the father's) name? (Jairus, vs. 41)

 - a) What was the name of the King of Bashan? (Og, vs. 1)
 - b) What was the name of the King of the Amorites? This was the same King that "dwelt at Heshbon?" (Sihon, vs. 2)

 - d) What piece of furniture is described in some detail as it relates to Og the king of Bashan? (His bed, vs. 11)
